Summary: Volunteer position

Do you have creative vision? Dream of bringing a playwright's script to life by leading the cast and crew through the process?

Do you have experience as a crew member, actor, or director of a play? Or, are you currently working on a Drama Studies degree and need practical experience?

We have an opportunity for you to build your portfolio.

We are seeking a volunteer director to provide directions for [World War II Christmas Radio](#). This adult amateur play needs you to help select the cast and provide direction. We will produce two performances in December.

We only ask that you remain in budget and adhere to the Library's policies and standards of service. Otherwise, you can have full creative control.

An applicant must have the ability to creatively interpret a script and imagine how the production will look. You must be a detail-oriented, organized, a leader and multi-tasker. You should be capable of planning and juggling a wide range of duties while staying within budget.

You also need to be able communicate your vision clearly to others.

How to Apply

Each applicant needs to meet with the Special Projects Librarian for a volunteer position interview. We highly encourage you to review the play before meeting.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities

- Provide stage and acting directions to the cast,
- Communicate frequently with the library to meet obstacles or needs,
- Commit to attending all rehearsals, performances, and any meetings that are needed,
- Ability to stay in allotted budget.

Qualifications

- Experience acting, directing, or producing plays; or currently enrolled in a Drama Studies program from an accredited university,
- Ability to manage time and schedule for play rehearsals.

Standards of Performance

- Punctual to all performances, rehearsals, and meetings,
- Adherence to contract and licensing agreements,
- Have Flexibility, enthusiasm, patience, and leadership qualities.
