

Sign up for a Teen Triad Card at the Twinsburg Public Library!

The Twinsburg Public Library is offering the new Teen Triad Cards to students ages 13-17 who don't have library cards or have them but are lost, blocked, etc. The Triad Card grants students access to the library and computers and enables them to check out up to three Twinsburg Public Library books at a time without a parental signature. A courtesy letter is sent home to the parents of students who have signed up for a Teen Triad Card to inform them their child has a card that gives them access to filtered internet. **Starting now through the end of September, any student needing to replace an already existing card will get one for FREE.** All students are encouraged to have a regular library card, which requires parents to be present to sign the application. Twelve year olds should ask about the Three For Me card.

The Twinsburg Public Library's goal is to help after-school unsupervised students check out books for their required reading. Students also need to have library cards with them in order to log onto computers. In cases of emergencies, it also provides the library with parental contact information.
